SENATE REPUBLICAN POLICY COMMITTEE – JOHN PIPPY, CHAIRMAN

## Wednesday, September 30, 2009

[Senate Bill 1093](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$1,563,000 to the Trustees of Drexel University in Philadelphia for instruction and student aid during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 39-10.**

[Senate Bill 1094](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$1,467,000 to the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine for instruction in the Doctor of Osteopathy program during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 40-9.**

[Senate Bill 1095](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$415,000 to the Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine, Erie for instruction in the Doctor of Osteopathy program for the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 40-9.**

[Senate Bill 1096](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$378,000 to Salus University, Philadelphia for instruction during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 40-9.**

[Senate Bill 1097](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$271,000 to the University of the Arts in Philadelphia for instruction and student aid during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 36-13.**

[Senate Bill 1098](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$43,000 to the Johnson Technical Institute of Scranton for the operation and maintenance of the school during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 35-14.**

[Senate Bill 1099](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$16,000 to the Williamson Free School of Mechanical Trades in Delaware County for the operation and maintenance of the school during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 35-14.**

[Senate Bill 1100](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$345,000 to the Fox Chase Institute for Cancer Research in Philadelphia for the operation and maintenance of the cancer research program during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 41-8.**

[Senate Bill 1101](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$95,000 to the Wistar Institute in Philadelphia for the operation and maintenance of the institute during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. The bill would also appropriate \$41,000 to the institute for research on acquired immune deficiency syndrome. **Passed: 41-8.**

[Senate Bill 1102](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$58,000 to the Central Penn Oncology Group for the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 41-8.**

[Senate Bill 1103](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$26,000 to the Lancaster Cleft Palate for outpatient-inpatient treatment during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. **Passed: 41-8.**

[Senate Bill 1104](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$186,000 to the Burn Foundation in Philadelphia for outpatient and inpatient treatment during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. [Passed: 41-8.](#)

[Senate Bill 1105](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$431,000 to The Children's Institute in Pittsburgh for the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year for the treatment and rehabilitation of children and young adults with disabling diseases. [Passed: 41-8.](#)

[Senate Bill 1106](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$200,000 to The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia for comprehensive patient care for children from birth through age 19 and for general maintenance and operation of the hospital during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. [Passed: 41-8.](#)

[Senate Bill 1107](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$317,000 to the Philadelphia Health and Education Corporation for continued pediatric outpatient and inpatient treatment of severe physically disabling diseases during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. [Passed: 41-8.](#)

[Senate Bill 1108](#) (Corman) would appropriate \$49,000 to the Beacon Lodge Camp for services to the blind during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year. [Passed: 41-8.](#)

[Senate Resolution 185](#) (Baker) designates the month of October 2009 as "Pennsylvania Fire Prevention Month" and observes the week of October 4 through 10, 2009 as "National Fire Prevention Week" in Pennsylvania. [Adopted by Voice Vote.](#)
